



SAFETY AND HEALTH POLICY

Applies To:

This policy applies to all GTG operations.

Introduction and Background or Purpose:

GTG recognizes the importance of safety and health to business success. GTG management has set forth requirements to assure identification and management of health and safety risks and compliance with country and state laws. Expectations are established to comply with GTG health and safety standards and its legal obligations including country, local and all other applicable statutory provisions and relevant codes of practice in order to continuously improve performance and be a leader in safety and health.

Requirements or Expectations:

Overall responsibility for compliance with this document is assigned to the Environmental, Health and Safety, and Research & Development organizations.

GTG is committed to the safety and health of all its employees and will provide a safe and healthy workplace worldwide. Hazards in GTG's workplaces must be well understood and effectively managed to protect GTG employees, visitors, facilities, and surrounding communities. To perform job duties effectively, employees at all levels are accountable for workplace safety and health, and must be committed to:

- Incorporating appropriate safety and health considerations into daily job duties and business decisions.
- Meeting or exceeding applicable health and safety laws and regulations, the requirements of GTG's Environment, Safety and Health Management Standard and other related GTG Policies and Standards.
- Designing, maintaining, and operating equipment, facilities, and processes in a safe manner.
- Using process hazard management systems to prevent hazardous chemical releases or conditions that have the potential to cause fires or explosions.
- Developing and participating in training and education programs to manage health and safety risks both on and off the job.
- Communicating with management and coworkers about working conditions perceived to be unsafe or hazardous and, as appropriate, shutting down any operation deemed to be operating in an unsafe condition.
- Sharing the results and conclusions of safety and health studies and contributing to the actions taken.
- Participating in safety incident and illness investigations, audits, and follow-up activities. This policy applies to Health and Safety related to the business operations excluding Product Health and Safety. Health and Safety expectations related to GTG products is addressed in the Product Safety and Health Policy.
